Rep. Bob Dixon to Testify Before Property Tax Reform Task Force

Jefferson City – This week, a citizen task force charged with examining issues surrounding property tax law in Missouri will gather in Springfield. Rep. Bob Dixon, R-Springfield, will be in attendance to testify before the task force on behalf of his constituents. The Task Force on Property Tax Reform is scheduled to hold its public hearing from 12:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m., at the Library Center on 4653 South Campbell Road.

“Far too many people in this area, and across the state, are struggling to meet the heavy financial burden that results from property taxes,” said Rep. Dixon. “Our goal must be to reform the system in order to ease this burden. I am confident the task force can find an equitable solution, one which balances the needs of the citizens of our state with those of our schools and other services that rely on property taxes as a source of funding.”

The Task Force on Property Tax Reform was formed in September and seeks to address property tax reform in an all-encompassing manner, including examining how assessments are currently done and considering approaches taken by other states to ease the strain of property taxes on their citizens. The group is made up of a diverse group of Missourians including retirees, home builders, school board members and county assessors.

The hearing in Springfield will be the second one held by the task force. Additional meetings will be held throughout the state.
