Rep. Bob Dixon to Host “Dare to Care for Kids Tour”—Public Invited

Springfield – Next week, Rep. Bob Dixon, R-Springfield, will kick off his 2007 “Dare to Care for Kids Tour.” Those who participate will learn about an entire spectrum of services available to children, from infants and toddlers to youth. Gaining firsthand knowledge about the needs of Springfield’s children will be an important part of the tour, but participants also can learn how they and their friends and families can contribute to helping children.

The tour is open to the public. It will last from approximately 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. each day. Complimentary charter transportation to each facility will be provided, as well as lunch. Reservations will be accepted until Friday, November 9th. Call 1-866-291-5077 to make a reservation.

Those who are unable to participate all three days are invited to attend a particular day of their choice as well. On Monday (November 12th), tour sites will include Isabel’s House (the Crisis Nursery of the Ozarks), the Judevine Center, and the Developmental Center of the Ozarks. Additionally, there will be presentations by Burrell Behavioral Health and CoxHealth.

The tour continues on Tuesday (November 13th). On this day, the sites to be visited include the Boys & Girls Clubs of Springfield, the Community Partnership of the Ozarks, St. John’s Health Center, the Caring Communities Project, and the Pregnancy Care Center.

The “Dare to Care” Tour concludes on Wednesday (November 14th). Destinations on this final day include Bailey Alternative High School (Springfield Public Schools), Boys & Girls Town of Missouri, the Child Advocacy Center, the Greene County Children’s Division, and Lost & Found of the Ozarks.
