Rep. Bob Dixon's Bill on Religious Documents Passed in Committee *HB 2110 Would Allow for the Display of Religious, Founding Documents*

Jefferson City, MO — On Tuesday, March 25th Rep. Bob Dixon's House Bill 2110 was voted out of the Special Committee on General Laws. HB 2110 prohibits any governing authority, board, commission, or the personnel of a political subdivision from preventing the display of religious documents in public buildings or on public lands.

"Our nation was founded upon Judeo-Christian beliefs that are apparent in many of the documents written during the time our country was establishing itself," noted Rep. Dixon. "Display of such documents in public places showcases the historic development of America."

House Bill 2110 defines founding documents of Missouri and the United States to include those with religious references. The bill passed on a 6-4 vote with two members absent. As pursuant to the House rules, once HB 2110 as makes it through the Rules Committee, the bill will be subject to floor debate for its third reading.
