## **House Passes Ronald Reagan Day Legislation** *HCR 23 Designates February 6<sup>th</sup> as "Ronald Reagan Day" in Missouri*

**Jefferson City, MO** — By a vote of 98-to-44, the Missouri House approved House Concurrent Resolution 23 on Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. Introduced by Representative Bob Dixon (R-Springfield), HCR 23 honors and recognizes the 40<sup>th</sup> President of the United States by designating February 6<sup>th</sup> as "Ronald Reagan Day" in Missouri.

"Missouri is closer to joining the ranks of forty-two other states that have taken the initiative by honoring a devoted and accomplished president," said Rep. Dixon. "Ronald Reagan was an American patriot who loved freedom and helped make it a reality for millions around the world."

Rather than establishing a state holiday, HCR 23 marks February 6<sup>th</sup> as a day of remembrance and honor for President Reagan. Forty-two states already honor Reagan through proclamations, Reagan Days, and historical landmarks.

The resolution now heads to the Senate for consideration.
